

arrived at Bournemouth. He felt at
times that therefore on August 24 1850 and after
making his journey in London arrived early although
tired. It is doubtful whether he had any present
illness that he was never to return. A few days after his
arrival at Bournemouth he went for a trip to Cowes and
caught a chill which brought on temperature from the
lungs.

On the day of his previous state reaching St. Mary's
Hospital and St. Mary's Hall both communities
ended in a novena which ended on the 14th of
September. He rallied from his first attack but on
Sunday the 8th a complication of pneumonia appeared.
